The project

The service of the volunteers focuses on two main fields: organising and implementing English language clubs for different target groups of the local community; and working with youth in Csongrád County aiming to promote solidarity projects and volunteering abroad.

You will manage English language clubs in four different venues: kindergarten, children's hospital, tanoda (afternoon school for disadvantaged students) and in a community space. Besides that, you will represent and promote volunteering, especially international volunteering for the students of high schools. Based on their needs and skills, you need to use creative, non-formal methods to reach the goals of the project.

You will have the opportunity to learn Hungarian language, get to know Hungarian culture through different, funny programmes and trips. You will be involved in the everyday's life of our organisation and you will be able to access into some of our other volunteering projects, try out yourself in managing civil society's events. You will be part of a cool, international team!

Located 160 km from Budapest, Szeged is a regional centre in the South Plain Region of Hungary, and the third biggest town of the country with approximately 160,000 inhabitants. It is often referred to as 'The City of Sunshine' in Hungary, as on average, it receives the biggest number of sunlit hours a year (but don't be surprised from the snow in winter...)!
