HOSTING ORGANISATION

Komm!unity is a NGO in Wörgl, that is specialized on youth, integration and community work. We run several youth centers, a street work department (mobile youth work), a youth information center, a culture venue, and integration and diversity department.

Our target groups are young people and migrants in our region. Furthermore, we also work with multipliers (all people in our region working or living with young people and migrants). Komm!unity aims to create and support an inclusive community for all people living in Wörgl.

Our youth centers are places for young people between 12 and 18 years to spend their leisure time. The youth centres provide space for various needs of young people and are open to all, regardless of social, religious or ethnic background. On the one hand, the youth centres offer a free space for youngsters, where they play table football, numerous board and card games, Playstation or just hang around. On the other hand, the youth centres organize a variety of events, workshops and excursions. The youth workers also support young people in creating and carrying out their own projects.

The culture centre ZONE.Kultur organizes and hosts various events, concerts, workshops and exhibitions for young and old.

Whether it is Chill & Grill in the summer for the whole family, poetry slam, concerts, cabaret, film or theater performances – the ZONE stage, bar and it's garden offers a unique ambience throughout the year.

LOCATION

The NGO komm!unity is based in Wörgl, in the Austrian federal state of Tyrol. Wörgl is a small town with 13.000 inhabitants. It is located 15 kilometers from Kufstein (the capital of the region), 55 kilometers from Innsbruck (the capital of Tyrol) and 100 kilometers from Munich, Germany.

Wörgl has many shopping facilities and opportunities to spend leisure time, like concert halls, sports complexes and a beautiful surrounding nature.

The state of Tyrol is a mountainous region with a lot of possibilities to do sports and outdoor activities like hiking, skiing, swimming or climbing.

TASKS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE VOLUNTEER

The volunteer will work in our youth centres and the culture centre ZONE.

The tasks and activities of the volunteer are:

- Supporting the youth workers in the youth centre
- offering drinks and snacks to the young people
- playing games and talking with young people
- taking part in different events in the youth centre
- planning and carrying out small projects together with the young people
- supporting the ZONE team in cultural work
- preparing and decorating the location, bar service during the events, taking photos etc.

Furthermore the volunteer will be part of:

- Frauencafé (project, where women with different cultural backgrounds learn and practice speaking German with each other)
- Dinnerclub (intercultural dinner, where different groups of people cook)
- InfoEck (youth information center)

The tasks in those departments are:

- working on some easy paperwork and administrative tasks
- making photos and postings for our social media channels
- cooking lunch once a week for the team (also doing the shopping for the meal)
- supporting the Dinnerclub team (organizing, decorating, serving at the event)
- bring in motivation and own ideas

Other opportunities as volunteer at our organization:

- participating at projects of other komm!unity departments such as integration and diversity, leisure time work project (I-Motion) or other youth centers
- there is a network of international volunteers in Tyrol and the volunteer has the possibility to take part in regular meetings and free time activities

PROFILE OF THE VOLUNTEER

We would be happy to host a volunteer who...

- is between 18 and 30 years old
- is interested in youth work and cultural work
- is open minded and communicative
- is motivated to bring in his/her own ideas
- is motivated to learn and practice German

We are open to include participants with fewer opportunities, whether due to social, economic or geographical obstacles, educational difficulties, or cultural differences.

We ask for your understanding: Only European Union (EU) or European Economic Area (EEA) residents can apply for this position.

PRACTICALITIES

Accommodation

The volunteer will live in an apartment in Wörgl, that is centrally located and in a walking distance from the work place in Wörgl. He/she will share the apartment with another young person. The volunteer will have his/her own room. There is a shared kitchen and a bathroom.

Food

The volunteer is responsible for buying and cooking for him/herself. The volunteer will receive a monthly food allowance from the hosting organization.

Pocket money

The volunteer will get 150 Euro pocket money per month.

Local transport

The volunteer will have a bike and a ticket for local transport (bus & train) in the region.

German Course

Once or twice a week the volunteer will attend German lessons in a training and qualification institute.
