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The project

The project is being coordinated by Decko and funded by Erasmus+ through the National Agency of Czech Republic.

Topic

The aim is to inform and train youth leaders and, subsequently, youngsters on how to use the internet in a way that protects their physical and online safety, as well as their digital and real-life reputation. It will also be a great opportunity to teach youngsters on how to make use of good online communication practices that promote tolerance and inclusion, instead of a culture of aggression. At its most heightened form, an inappropriate use of the internet and any kind of digital harassment might result in low self-esteem, depression, low academic achievement and overall less interest in school. We want to show that it is essential to tackle the issue of cybersafety and cyberbullying through prevention, in order to avoid the biggest and most harmful consequences of this phenomenon to youngsters from all over Europe.

Training Course

As the first part of the project a training course was organized in Nachod, between 9-13 November 2016, where youth leaders and people that work with the youngsters had the opportunity to exchange knowledge and ideas on cyberbullying and other cyberthreats and discuss on how to enhance cybersafety.



What about the youth exchange?

The youth exchange is the second part of the project which is going to take part in Greece. 24 young people and 7 youth leaders will have the chance to create together an exchange on cybersafety and begin an intercultural dialogue in order to create a safe cyberspace.

Profile of leaders

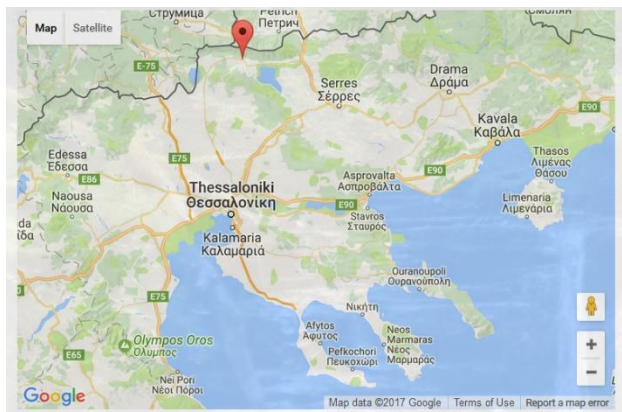
The leaders have no age limit but are expected to be highly motivated in helping and contributing to every day's activities, evaluation and dissemination results. There will be 2 leaders for Greece and Czech Republic and one leader for Poland, Portugal and Lithuania.

Accommodation

The project is going to take part in Kato Poroia, 90 km northern from Thessaloniki. It is going to be hosted by the Environmental Center of the area so we will have plenty of common spaces and opportunities to explore the rich nature of the area during the activities. We will inform you early enough on where and how we will meet to go there all together by bus.



How to get there?

Closest airport is SKG Macedonia Airport in Thessaloniki. We will arrange all together how to go to Kato Poroia according to the arrival times of your flights. Please, keep in mind that the transfer between Thessaloniki and Kato Poroia will cost 20 euros per person.

Reimbursement

Decko will be responsible for the travelling arrangements. Before you buy any tickets you should inform Decko via email: youthinaction@seznam.cz

All participants have to provide all their travel documents (flight, train and shuttle tickets, boarding passes) to Decko. There will be no reimbursement during the project. It will be done by bank transfer after the visit according to the travel documents that we will receive from participants.

You should provide us with the following:

1. Invoice copy or copy of credit card slip
2. Boarding pass
3. The completed travel reimbursement form, provided by us
4. All relevant tickets (plane, train, etc)

For Electronic Tickets, you should also keep the Boarding pass and invoice or copy of credit card slip/e-banking printout as well as the travel itinerary. Please note that no electronic tickets can be reimbursed if the invoice or copy of the credit card slip/ e-banking printout will not be provided.

All tickets must be bought until **15th May** but make sure you do it as early as possible as it is Greece and it will be summer so it will be very hard to find cheap tickets.
